Congress is directing the inspections and is having an independent, third party contractor come to identify issues, and ensure all private housing is in compliance with applicable housing codes. So they will be inspecting every single home inside and out in every private military community like ours. The intent is to ensure your home is safe and habitable. Friendly Reminders

Please assist us in keeping your community looking great! Our team is joined by our Navy Housing Partners to ensure residents are following community policies & guidelines. Please make sure any toys or play equipment is properly stored when not in use by the end of the day, trash and recycle bins are not overflowing, flags being displayed are not torn or faded, nothing is being hung on your fences, pet waste is picked up and your backyard grass is cut and watered. You may obtain this information, along with additional policies & guidelines in your community handbook.

Cooling Homes

- Keep blinds and curtains closed during the day (Purchase black-out curtains if possible) (Foil is not permitted)
- Use a portable air conditioner (Window units are not permitted)
- Keep entry doors closed during the day
- Close interior doors to rooms and closets that do not need cooling
- Set your ceiling fans to turn counter-clockwise, there's a switch above the light to change the direction
- Heat rises. In 2-story homes if upstairs is too hot move to the ground floor.
- If your home is too hot, head to somewhere cooler: the lake, a store, the mall, or even come hang out at the community center.

Summer Reminders

- Please test waters before jumping into them. Bodies of water stay colder for longer in the PNW. It might be 75 degrees outside, but the waters could be 40 degrees still. Jumping into them can cause even the most skilled swimmer to go into shock and drown. Please be cautious!
- Make sure younger residents have life jackets before heading to the lake. Davies Beach in Lake Stevens has a place to pick up free life jackets.
- Make sure to drink plenty of water and wear sunscreen.
- Do not leave young residents and pets unattended outside, in garages or areas without air circulation, or in cars.
